


Monitoring Data Show Few Counties Would Not Meet Proposed Secondary Fine Particle Standards

(Based on 2008-2010 Air Monitoring Data)



- 3 counties would not meet a proposed secondary fine particle standard of 30 deciviews
- 6 additional counties would not meet a proposed secondary fine particle standard of 28 deciviews

Elkhart County, Indiana is the only county that would meet the proposed range for the primary standard but not meet a proposed secondary standard of 28 deciviews.

Note: EPA will not designate areas as nonattainment on these data, but likely on 2011-2013 data which are expected to show improved air quality

There are no violations outside the contiguous 48 states
