

Because of a conflict with a public advisory teleconference of the Clean Air Scientific Advisory Committee (CASAC) regarding the committee's comments on the proposed revisions to the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for lead, **EPA is rescheduling the tribal/state webconferences on the proposal to Wednesday July 23. Please note that the public comment period on this proposed rule has been extended through Monday, August 4, 2008.**
