

On Tuesday, October 18, 2011, at from 4 pm-5:30 pm (Eastern), EPA will host a webinar on the air regulations for petroleum refineries, which are scheduled to be proposed by December 10, 2011.

The webinar is designed for community members who would like a better understanding of the refinery industry and how the industry is regulated under the Clean Air Act. The webinar provides an opportunity for communities, particularly environmental justice communities, to understand the process and provide input.

The webinar is part of EPA's overall effort to reach many stakeholder groups who may be interested in this rulemaking. EPA has held discussions with and made presentations to other stakeholder groups regarding this rulemaking. All stakeholders will be able to access the webinar materials on line at www.epa.gov/air/ej subsequent to the webinar.

EPA plans to further engage stakeholders and host another webinar after the petroleum refinery rulemaking is proposed.

Tuesday's webinar, entitled "Addressing Air Emissions from the Petroleum Refinery Sector: Risk and Technology Review and New Source Performance Standard Rulemaking," builds on EPA's earlier Clean Air Act 101 webinar for communities.
