The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will present an overview of the proposed revisions to the national ambient air quality standards (NAAQS) for particulate matter (PM). Also, the EPA will outline:

- Proposed updates to PM monitoring requirements, including a proposed requirement for near-road PM_{2.5} measurements.
- Proposed revisions to the prevention of significant deterioration (PSD) permitting program with respect to the proposed revisions in the standards.
- Expected implementation timeline for the proposed standards.

Following the presentation, the EPA will answer clarifying questions. Note that although the EPA is hosting the webinar during the public comment period, the webinar is not a means of providing comment on the proposed rule.
